



Guidelines for Poster Presentations

27th International Conference on Bear Research and Management
Virtual Conference | September 14-16 & 21-23, 2021



General Description

All poster presenters will have an individualized 'booth' within the conference platform. Within that booth, presenters can share their posters along with a short video describing their poster (videos are optional). Posters have been assigned to a live poster session. Poster presenters are asked to be available within their booth during this time. Because of the international nature of this conference, we understand that attending live might not be possible for all presenters. To address this, within the booth, there is also an avenue for conference attendees to ask questions.

Submitting your poster

- All presenters will receive an email from CVENT (the conference platform) with instructions on how to log-in to the conference platform and submit posters. An optional training is also available; we recommend presenters view this training video for information on how to upload documents.

*****Posters must be submitted by August 30th*****

Guidelines

- Poster presenters can upload a traditional conference style poster, or submit a Power Point Presentation with a maximum of 5 slides that use the following heading: Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions or Management Implications.
- Presenters will have the option of submitting a short video explaining their poster. These videos must be a maximum of 5 minutes.
- Other supplementary materials are allowed.

Suggestions for Poster Design

- Keep the text brief and report only key aspects of each section. Suggested word count is 300 to 500 words.
- Use large font size. Simple typefaces are preferable to fancy fonts.
- Use bullets, numbering and headlines to make it easy to read.
- Keep figures simple. Convey only one idea per figure, table or photograph.
- White backgrounds are generally best for text.

- Use appropriate blank space between words, sections and figures.

Other Information

- Files should be named using the following format: lastname_firstname
- Poster documents must not exceed 20MB in size and associated optional videos must not exceed 5GB in size.
- Acceptable file formats for documents include .doc, .docx, .gif, .jpg, .jpeg, .pdf, .png, .ppt, .pptx, .txt, .xls, .xlsx. Videos must be either .MP4 or .MOV
