- Lead and facilitate Conservation Projects and Programs in North America
- Develop and oversee education programs and outreach workshops
- Promote the educational lesson plans and projects in the Yukon, British Columbia, NWT, Nunavut and Alaska
- Help raise funds for mission accomplishment
- Write grants for BTI programs
- Report quarterly to the ED on the current status of projects and progress reports
- Promote hunting when data shows to do so, for example in B.C. and NWT
- Partner side by side with First Nations to benefit bear conservation and the youth
- Get our lesson plans in schools in the Yukon and NWT
- Lead the research and development of our bear studies
- Report quarterly to the ED and board on current status of projects and progress reports
- Raise money through F&W for grizzly studies

- Promote hunting of Grizzlies and write recommendation letters to NWT ministers to promote the start of hunting.
- Work on allowing the import of Polar Bears into the U.S.
